

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL SESSION  
OF THE ANNA CITY COUNCIL  
MARCH 19, 2019**

The Anna City Council met in special session at the Anna City Hall at 4:32 p.m. on March 19, 2019. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Steve Hartline. The roll call went as follows: Present were Commissioner Al Kamp, Commissioner David Tellor, Commissioner Martha Ann Webb, and Mayor Steve Hartline. Commissioner David Isom was absent.

Commissioner Isom entered the meeting at 4:35 p.m.

Public Hearing Tentative FY 2019-2020 Operating Budget. No public communication. City Administrator Steve Guined gave an overview of the budget pointing out that the city has \$2,193,720 cash on hand and \$3.7 million in investments which gives a total of \$5,893,720. The annual budget for 2019-2020 is 6.5 million.

Commissioner Isom commended City Administrator on doing a great job on the budget.

City Administrator Steve Guined highlighted a few issues: (1) Park Office was broken into. (2) There have been some major repairs on Lime Kiln Rd (3) Water line repairs on Industrial (4) The pump for the lift station on Brady Mill Rd came in today so they will be fixing that, but the lift station at Rusty's Home Center and Bethany Village is in need of repairs. (5) The brown water issue is thought to be resolved with help from AJ Water Commission, which was named Water Plant of the Year.

A motion was made by Commissioner Kamp and seconded by Commissioner Isom that it be **RESOLVED THAT THE SPECIAL SESSION OF THE ANNA CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF MARCH 19, 2019 BE ADJOURNED AT 4:53 P.M.** A vote was taken upon the motion with the following results. Commissioner Isom, Commissioner Kamp, Commissioner Tellor, Commissioner Webb, and Mayor Hartline voted yea. Nay – none. Mayor Hartline declared the motion carried.
