## MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE ANNA CITY COUNCIL DECEMBER 18, 2018

The Anna City Council met in regular session at the Anna City Hall at 5:00 p.m. on December 18, 2018. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Steve Hartline. The roll call went as follows: Present were Mayor Steve Hartline, Commissioner David Isom, Commissioner Al Kamp, and Commissioner Martha Webb. None were absent.

A motion was made by Commissioner Isom and seconded by Commissioner Kamp that it be *RESOLVED TO APPROVE THE DECEMBER 4, 2018 ANNA CITY COUNCIL REGULAR SESSION MINUTES AS THE OFFICIAL MINUTES OF SAID MEETING.* A vote was taken upon the motion with the following results. Commissioner David Isom, Commissioner Al Kamp, Commissioner Martha Webb, and Mayor Hartline voted yea. Nay – none. Mayor Hartline declared the motion carried.

Budget Officer Steve Guined submitted Financial Reports for November 30, 2018 previously.

Mayor Hartline asked Josh Ditto of Techs Guy to present the information for the sale of Cardinal Wireless to ProTeck Communications. Josh Ditto introduced Cameron McCurdy. Mayor Hartline questioned how many customers in Anna they are currently serving. Josh stated 100 customers. Mayor Hartline stated that the city is applying for a grant to upgrade and paint the water tower. Mr. McCurdy

stated that they will work with the painting company to either remove the equipment or pay to have the equipment painted around. City Attorney John Foley stated that the insurance would need to be equivalent or greater than the requirements for Tech Guys.
