GAS DEPARTMENT INFORMATION

If you think you smell gas, it could indicate a leak. Evacuate the premises immediately, then contact Anna City Hall at 833-8528 or dial 911. Do not light a match, turn on any electrical switch, flashlight or use a telephone, an electrical arc may ignite the gas, causing an explosion.

ORDINANCE 2020-13
