### **LEAF REMOVAL**

The City of Anna will be offering leaf and small limb pick-up the week of Nov. 15-19<sup>th</sup> and Dec. 6-10<sup>th</sup>. Leaves must be raked to the curb, but not in the street, and free from debris. Limbs must be no larger than 4" in diameter and should be placed at the curb separate from leaves.
