If you do not receive a utility bill by the 10th of every month, please contact Anna City Hall. Failure to receive your utility bill does not relieve customers of payment obligations.



BIG TRASH PICK UP

The city is offering BIG TRASH PICKUP the week of April 2-4, 2024. All trash must be set out with your regular trash to guarantee pickup. Items that do not qualify are electronics, tires, wiring, construction debris, hazardous chemicals, yard waste etc. If you are unsure whether an item qualifies, contact Anna City Hall at 833-8528.

REGULAR TRASH REMINDER

Do not put any yard waste into your trash or recycle totes this includes grass clippings, leaves, limbs etc.

REMINDER

Anna City Code Section 33-2-19 prohibits the discharge of cut grass, leaves and/or other debris on public streets within the city. Any person who violates this ordinance shall be given a written warning upon the first offense. Subsequent offenses shall be punishable by a fine of up to \$250, as well as clean-up cost and attorney fees when applicable.

TALL GRASS/WEED REMINDER

Anna City Code Section 25-2-2 regulates and provides for the abatement of tall grasses/weeds which constitute public nuisances. If found in violation of this ordinance, you may be subject to fine(s) and/or lien(s) against your property. For further information, please visit www.cityofanna.org or stop by City Hall for a copy.
