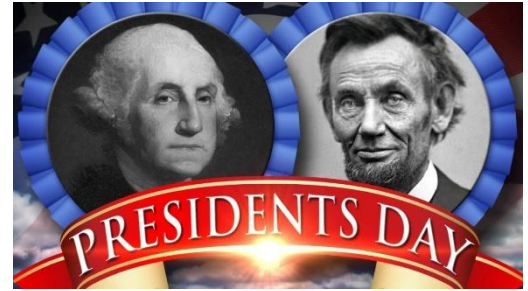


If you do not receive a Utility Bill by the 10th of every month, please contact Anna City Hall.
