BUILDING/FENCING/ZONING PERMITS & J.U.L.I.E.

Thinking of starting a project, a building permit is required for any structure. Stop by City Hall to pick up an application, or visit www.cityofanna.org. You must also call in a J.U.L.I.E. Locate at 800-892-0123 for all utility departments to come out and mark your lines. You will need to allow up to 48 hours for the lines to be marked.

CEMETERY INFORMATION

The City of Anna will start Spring Clean-up on March 2, 2026. All arrangements left on the ground after this date will be taken up and disposed of by the cemetery staff. If you have further inquiries, please contact the Anna City Hall at 833-8528.

DOOR TO DOOR SOLICITORS

The City of Anna requires solicitors to obtain a certificate of registration before they can go door to door. If someone comes to your door, you can request to see their certificate to ensure that they have been vetted and permitted to be soliciting.

REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES 3-1-3 (B)

Waste Products Accumulations. It shall be unlawful for any person to cause or permit a dog or cat to be on property, public or private, not owned or possessed by such person unless such person has in his immediate possession an appropriate device for scooping excrement and an appropriate depository for the transmission of excrement to a receptacle located upon property owned or possessed by such person. This section shall not apply to a person who is visually or physically handicapped.
