MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE ANNA CITY COUNCIL October 16, 2024

The Anna City Council met in regular session at Anna City Hall at 5:00 p.m. on October 15th, 2024. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Steve Hartline. The roll call went as follows: Present were Mayor Steve Hartline, Commissioner Kathy Bryan, Commissioner Torie Carter, and Commissioner Martha Ann Webb. Other members present were City Administrator Dori Bigler, and Treasurer Angela Webb. Commissioner Bigler entered at 5:04 p.m.

Mayor Hartline opened the floor to the public communications portion of the agenda. Crystal Houseman addressed the council regarding a "Witches Night Out" block party being held on October 25th, 2024. She spoke to the various business owners to ensure all are on board with closing Lafayette Street from 4-8pm. The Council agrees this is fine.

City Administrator Dori Bigler gave an update on November meetings.
