MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE ANNA CITY COUNCIL OCTOBER 7TH, 2025

The Anna City Council met in regular session at Anna City Hall at 5:00 p.m. on October 7th, 2025. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Steve Hartline. The roll call went as follows: Present were Mayor Steve Hartline, Commissioner Michael Bigler, Commissioner Kathy Bryan, Commissioner Torie Carter and Commissioner Martha Ann Webb. Other members present were City Administrator Dori Bigler, Public Works Manager Jordan Chamness, Police Chief Brent Sims, Fire Chief Tim Bowen, and Treasurer Angela Webb.

Mayor Hartline opened up the meeting to the public communications portion of the agenda.

Norma Hackney addressed to council requesting support and partnership with bringing the Freedom Sings USA and Heroes United IL program to Union County and Anna in April of 2026. The Shawnee Hills Arts Council will be in touch with Dori to work on details.

Delbert Riehn of Robinson Outdoors addressed the council requesting a reconsideration of the zoning variance for a sign permit requested in 2023. The council is uninterested in entertaining a reconsideration at this time.

City Administrator Bigler gave an update on the City's audit, Leaf and Limb pick up, and the water project.
