

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SESSION
OF THE ANNA CITY COUNCIL
APRIL 21st, 2026**

The Anna City Council met in regular session at Anna City Hall at 5:00 p.m. on April 21st, 2026. The meeting was called to order by Acting Mayor Kathy Bryan. The roll call went as follows: Present were Commissioner Torie Carter, Commissioner Michael Bigler, Commissioner Martha Webb, and Commissioner Kathy Bryan. Other members present were City Administrator Dori Bigler, Treasurer Angela Webb, Public Works Director Jordan Chamness, and Police Chief JD Barter. Mayor Steve Hartline was absent.

Commissioner Bryan opened up the floor for public communications.

City Administrator Bigler gave a few project updates. The city received the Tree City designation for the 8th year and will be planting a tree on Arbor Day with the Garden Club. She will have an updated concept for the Main Street design soon. The Zoning Board of Appeals has a variance hearing set for May 18th, 2026 and their recommendation will be on the May 19th agenda.
